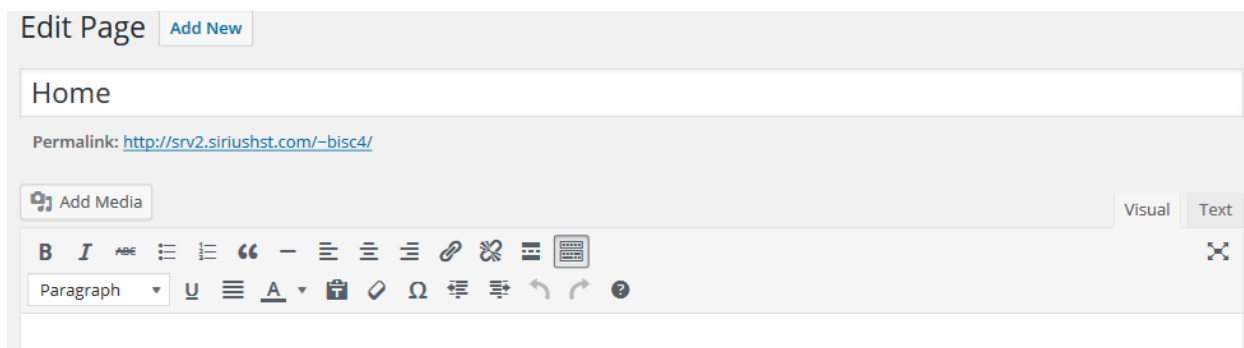
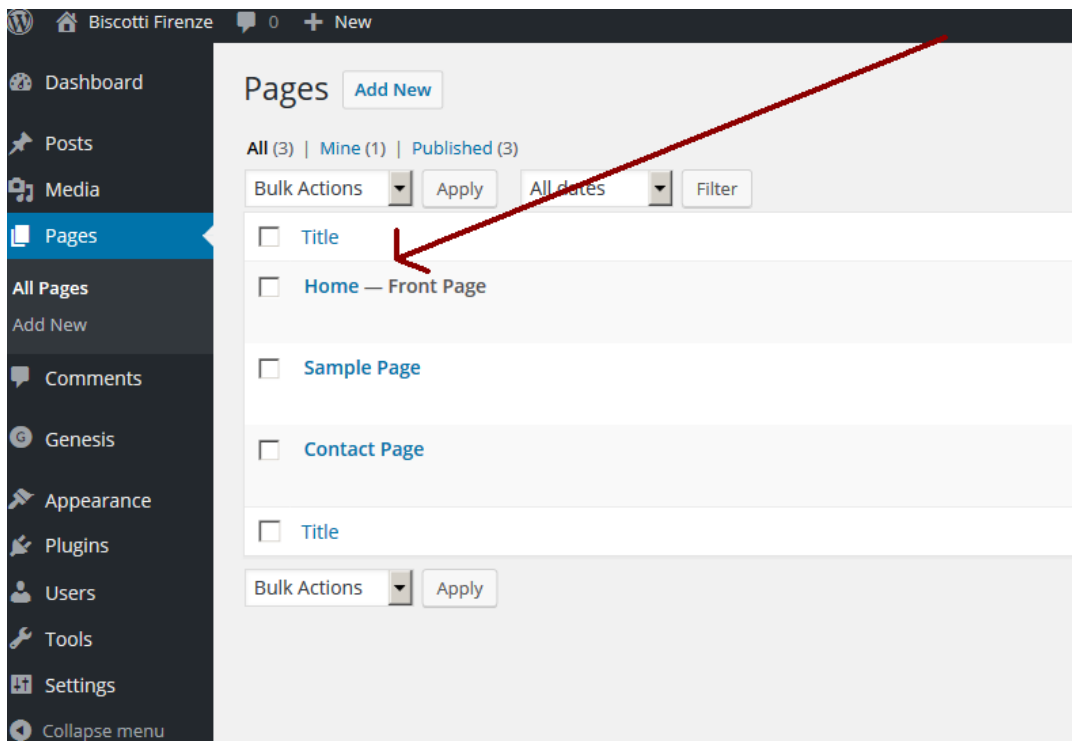
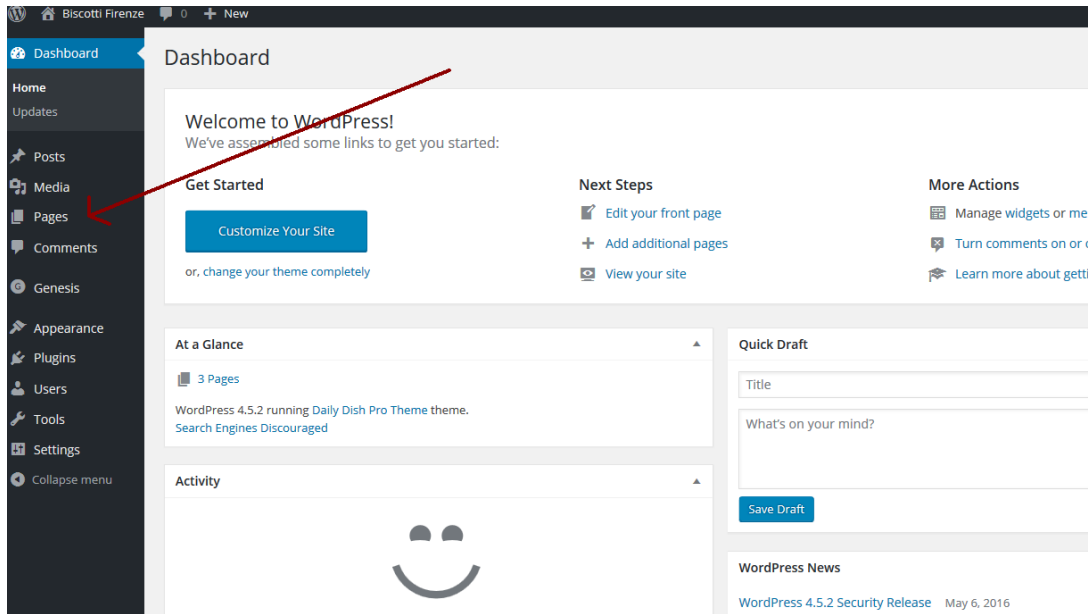
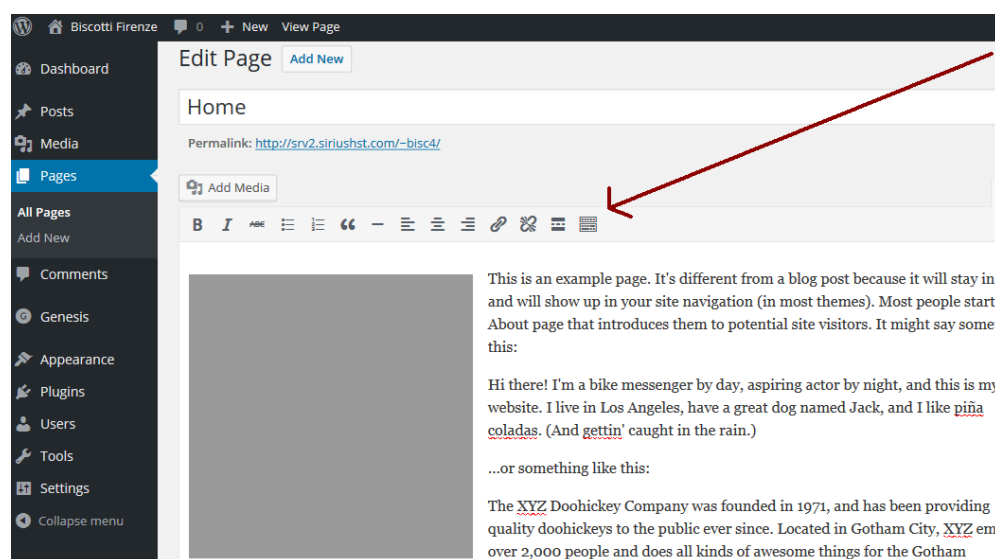


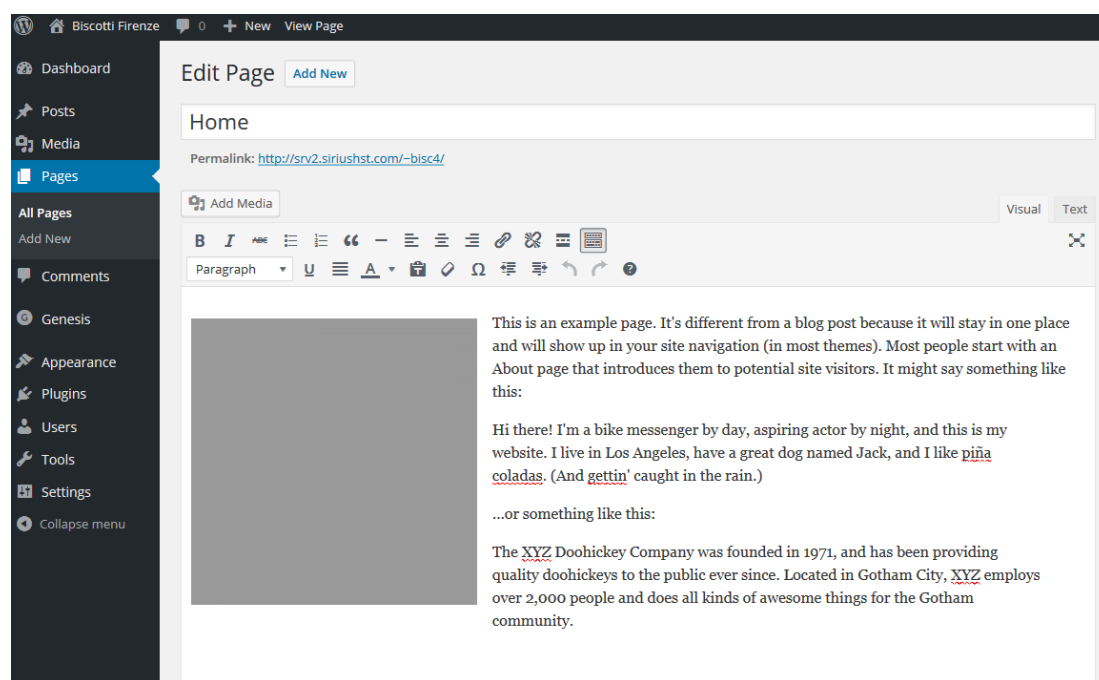
Basic Wordpress editing



Once in your page, click the editor to open it:



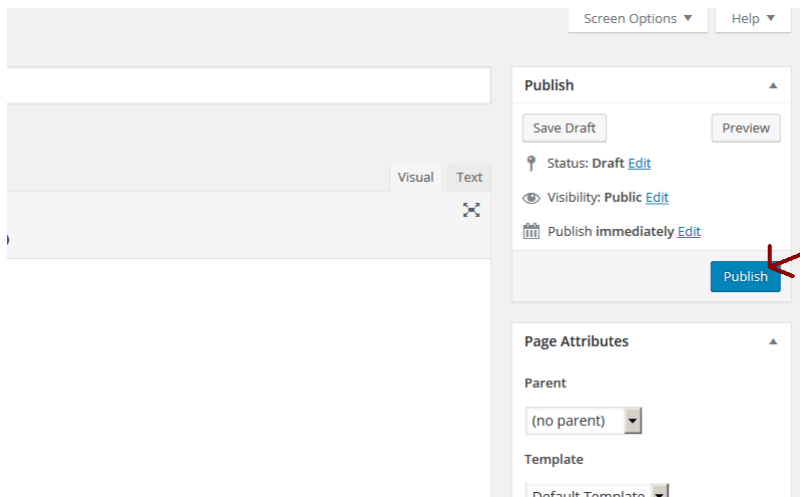
Now you can edit your text page. If you need more room on the site, I will hide the right sidebar, and you can use the full width of the website for content.



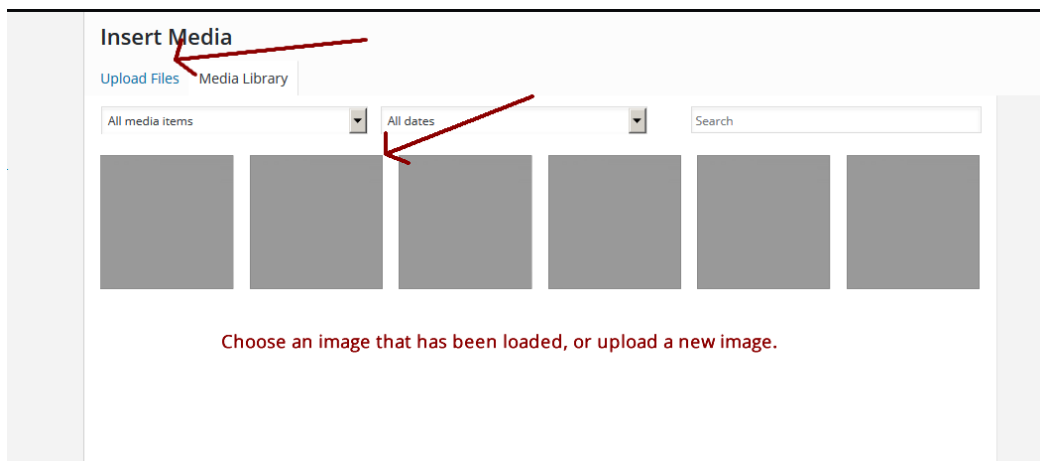
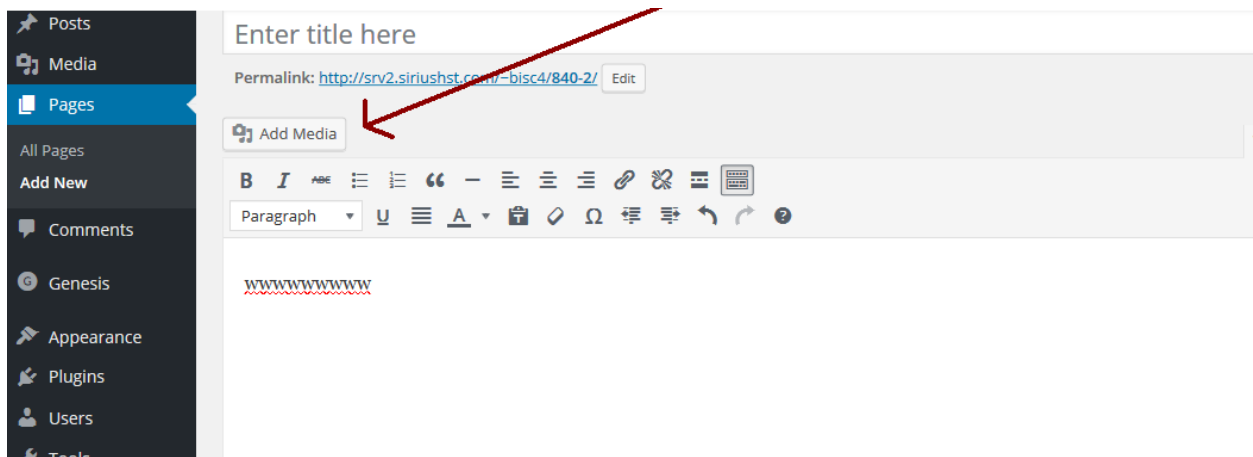
Once you are done editing, click PUBLISH or SAVE DRAFT. If you publish, the page is live immediately; but there is no menu button leading to it yet.

You can also click the PREVIEW button, to see how the page looks before saving.

If the page has already been saved once, that button will say UPDATE.



Use the Media button to add images to the page:



Place it. Align it left, center or right, and update. There are settings under each image that you can use to resize, if needed, but it's best to do that before you load them (as with any website.)
